- Under 13's must run within an arm's reach of a parent / guardian / other designated adult
- The participant's name and contact details will be kept by Waitrose in accordance with its privacy notice and will only be used in connection with the organisation and participation in the Wichelstowe Games. You have the right to have any date held about you removed at any time. Your information will be held for a maximum of 14 months following the completion of the Games and may be used to notify you of a future Games Event.
- Participants must follow instructions as given from all event staff, volunteers and marshals throughout the duration
 of the event. All safety instructions provided by event staff must be followed. All decisions regarding made by event
 organisers including scoring will be final.

- Support either verbally or in the form of signs and banners is encouraged but any participant or supporter who conducts themselves in an unsportsmanlike manner, or who is offensive by action or language to officials, volunteers, participants or spectators may be disqualified from the event or asked to leave.
- No persons are authorized to participate unless they are registered participants.
- By taking part, all participants confirm that they are happy for their any footage or photographs taken during their participation to be used to publicise the event and in marketing material produced by the supporting organisations. The winners name may also be used in marketing material.
- Participant event numbers are specific personal identifiers and may not be exchanged or transferred.
- Participants will ensure that they will on the Event Date, be sufficiently fit and healthy to participate in the event unaided and in accordance with these terms. If you are in any doubt we recommend that you seek medical advice.
- Parking will be provided but the event organisers will not be liable for any damage or loss to vehicles. Please ensure all valuables are kept out of sight.
- The event organisers reserve the right to refuse entry to the Event or to ask you to cease participation if:
 - a) you fail to follow instructions given by Event officials;
 - b) you attempt to participate in the Event in a manner that we, acting reasonably, believe: may cause injury to you or another participant; may damage or harm the environment; is likely to cause offence; or otherwise causes a risk or potential risk to health and safety
