Construction Update

As you can see in the photo above the canal is really starting to take shape in Wichels Fields. This 500m stretch running up to Mill Lane is the first step in joining up the East Wichel and the District Centre sections.

Following the transfer of further land from the Council, work will commence over the next month on two further areas of the site.

Parcel 8 will be built by Barratt Homes and is a continuation of Wichel Fields. This Parcel includes development to the north and south of the newly constructed Wichel Way.

Parcel 10 will be built by David Wilson Homes and is located within the Canalside area of the site.

Swindon Borough Council's Cabinet recently agreed the transfer of the next phase of land at Wichelstowe. Construction will soon begin on 616 new homes to expand the Canalside, Wichel Fields, Orchards Rise and Orchards View areas.

Councillor Kevin Small, Swindon Borough Council's Cabinet Member for Finance and Russell Glimstead, Regional Managing Director (West Region), Barratt Developments PLC and Wichelstowe LLP Board Chair met to mark the moment.
